



Gas Day Harmonisation

Transition Plan

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1 Introduction

1.1 Purpose

This document defines the approach Origin Energy Electricity Limited (Origin) is taking in response to a rule change to harmonise the start time of the gas day. Gas Day Harmonisation (GDH) means a gas day starting at 6.00 am AEST. The changes will be effective 01 October 2019.

For QLD, the transitional gas day – 30 September 2019 – will be a ‘short gas day’ of 22 hours beginning at 8.00 am AEST.

‘Standard gas day’ refers to a gas day starting at 6.00 am AEST.

1.3 Roma Pipeline

Origin is the owner of the Roma Pipeline. The Pipeline is operated by APA under an agreement with Origin.

Origin has engaged with third party owners to confirm their GDH readiness activities (associated with the Roma Pipeline).
